6 different types of assignments/problems

- Type 1: A well-defined problem – precise objectives – well-known technique – correct answer
- Type 2: A well-defined problem – precise objectives – choose the right method – correct answer
- Type 3: A well-defined problem – precise objectives – know methods can be used or new methods can be included – correct answer
- Type 4: A well-defined problem – precise objectives – encouraged to find their own answer of the problem – choose between different methods to find the best possible answer
- Type 5: A well-defined problem – precise objectives – encouraged to find their own criteria to find the best possible method and answer
- Type 6: It is decided which problem to work with together with the students (there is not a well-defined problem or theme) The students write/find their own objectives for the lesson and they have decide on their own how to solve the problem
